- Look to enforce Segen's product packaging policy with our supplier base to reduce nonrecyclable packaging.
- To wherever possible, ensure the segregation, re-use and recycling of waste.
- To ensure that environmental considerations are taken into account when selecting and monitoring third parties we may use in connection with our business.
- To minimise the effects of our activities on our neighbours & communities.
- Improve our product lifecycle planning with particular regard to end of life arrangements, WEEE instructions & avoidance of landfill disposal.
- To provide suitable and sufficient environmental information, instruction, training and supervision to enable our employees to carry out their jobs competently and responsibly with regards to the environment.
- Begin reporting of deliveries made with net zero solution.
- Build capability to report on Scope 3 GHG emissions from 2025.
- We also expect our suppliers to adopt a similar and we will collaborate with them on setting a baseline this year and we will be reporting improvements in subsequent years.

- Set baseline target of 15% recycling rate of all electronic waste via our third-party vendor.
- Set baseline target of 50% of packaging recycled or reused.

## **ENERGY CONSUMPTION & GHG EMISSIONS**

- ESOS/SECR reporting and widening scope and defining baseline.
- 100% target of renewable energy usage across the Segen estate.

### PRODUCT LIFECYCLE

- Set baseline 10% of products with Lifecycle Assessment Plans or Environmental Product
  Declarations
- % of suppliers using recyclable packaging.

## **ENVIRONMENTAL TRAINING**

- Set baseline 50% of management team trained on environmental management.
- Set baseline 50% of employees trained on environmental solutions.



# **Glossary**

**PV** – a term used for the technology of converting sunlight into electricity.

**UN Global compact** – a global framework to support companies to:

- 1. Do business responsibly by aligning their strategies and operations with <u>Ten Principles</u> on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption; and
- 2. Take strategic actions to advance <u>broader societal goals</u>, such as the <u>UN Sustainable Development</u> Goals, with an emphasis on collaboration and innovation

**Sustainable development goals (SDG's)** – a derivative of the UN global compact; there are 17 SDG's that can be aligned with as part of any social value policy.



**ESOS** – Energy savings opportunity scheme. A mandatory scheme that requires organisations in the UK to audit & report their energy use every 4 years.

WEEE – waste of electrical & electronic equipment and reporting

**Scope 3 GHG emissions** – carbon reporting from our suppliers (manufacturing & Logistics) and delivery carbon (to our customers)
